As the damage to the natural environment resulting from human activity has increased dramatically recently, sustainability has grown ever more important. Globally, the idea of sustainability has been underlined in the World Commission on Environment and Development Report (UN, 1987). According to this report, the human race has a responsibility to honor the right to live of the following generations while it seeks its own. Today, sustainability means fair, inclusive, and equitable continuation of the earth with its social, economic, and environmental features, living creatures, natural resources, and all aspects of human life. Aiming to help in sustainable development, istanbul Bilgi University embraces this multi-dimensional view of sustainability. September 2024 sees an update to Istanbul Bilgi University's Sustainability Policy in this regard.

Istanbul Bilgi University (BİLGİ) has embraced values including equality of opportunity, reduction of inequities, academic freedom, appreciation of diversity, and inclusion as the building blocks of its own identity ever since its founding. Under these values, BİLGİ sees gender equality and its application as absolutely necessary for its existence.

Based on THE Impact Rankings in 2021 and 2022 BİLGİ has been listed among the top 101-200 universities worldwide on gender equality since it has already acted towards incorporating gender equality in its policies, programs, curricula, and operations.

A strategic instrument, the <u>Gender Equality Plan (GEP)</u> helps define particular initiatives aiming at both the present difficulties and the obligations to support gender equality in the institution. BİLGİ GEP 2022-2027 has thus been created to methodically and strategically guarantee equitable opportunity for all of its members.

Approved by the Rector's Office, the BİLGİ GEP is now before the Board of Trustees and the University Senate. The GEP of Istanbul Bilgi comprises policies created in line with the demands of the university and the current contextual analysis.

As BİLGİ, we are collaborating with all stakeholders to guarantee that our activities, policies, decisions, and practices are in accordance with the universal human rights law and the principle of equality related to this matter. We are of the opinion that it is crucial to establish an activity program that takes into account the evolving requirements of the community, as well as principles such as inclusivity, diversity, and equality. On the basis of this perspective our Equality Diversity, and Inclusion Policy is applicable to all salaried or voluntary staff, existing and potential students, external auditors, consultants, and individuals who visit our campuses and other facilities, as well as all living beings on our campuses.

At BİLGİ, 367 courses covering environmental themes and 19 courses directly linked to sustainability exist. BİLGİ's sustainability courses directly complement the Sustainable Development Goals of the United Nations and the aims of its Strategic Plan for 2024–2027: "D.1.1. To increase students' awareness of social and ecological impact and strengthen their competencies," and "D.1.2. To increase the number of activities, research, and projects aimed at identifying and solving social and ecological issue," respectively. With over 100 courses covering each of the objectives of Peace, Justice, and Strong Institutions, Gender Equality, and Reduced Inequalities, BİLGİ gives its students and the community chances to increase understanding of each.

Established in 2003, the Center for Civil Society Studies mostly aims to assist in the growth of a civil society both in Türkiye and abroad. By means of scientific research, application and training programs, publishing and documentation on the social, economic, and cultural aspects of this development, the Center seeks

to add to this progress. Working with state and corporate institutions as well as non-governmental groups, it aims to help to compile knowledge in allied disciplines. Three independent units make up the center: the Youth Studies Unit, the Child Studies Unit, and the NGO Training and Research Unit. It also features the Master's Program in Social Projects and NGO Management as well as the Bilgi Incubation Center. Apart from that, it provides courses and does research on civil society in several undergraduate degrees. To develop their institutional capacities by giving civil society initiatives working on rights in the city (e.g., CSRs, initiatives, platforms, informal groups) different learning opportunities, the rather new Bilgi Social Incubation Center hosts seminars for them.

CCSS stands out with The Social Incubation Center, located on Istanbul Bilgi University's santralistanbul Campus, established in December 2014. It was designed as a resource center that could be used to meet the changing needs of civil society, particularly in Istanbul. The center is engaged in activities for grassroots organizations that need assistance in developing their organizational capacity in a particular area. It is the first incubation center in Türkiye that supports non-profit organizations.

Istanbul Bilgi University Child Studies Unit: http://cocuk.bilgi.edu.tr istanbul Bilgi University Child Studies Unit, founded in 2007, works in the training, research and advocacy fields aiming at the realization of children's rights. With the active participation of the children, the Unit endeavors to contribute to the policies developed concerning children in Türkiye. The main stakeholders of the Unit are children aged between 0-18, people and organizations working for and around the children and those who contribute to the development of child policies.

Istanbul Bilgi University Youth Studies Unit: http://genclik.bilgi.org.tr It was founded in 2006, has also been working under the Civil Society Studies Center of Istanbul Bilgi University. The Unit has been running projects on 4 main program areas mainly Advocacy, Research, Networking and Modeling in order to contribute to the recognition of youth work and to develop youth policy proposals for a more a democratic youth policy in Türkiye. processes in the politics, legal systems, societies and economies of Europe.

To this end, the European Institute supports interdisciplinary academic programmes in EU studies and undertakes interdisciplinary research focusing on issues such as processes of integration, Europeanisation, multiculturalism, diversity and the construction of European identities.

Among many other EU-funded (numerous FP7 projects, Horizon Projects) and international projects, the Institute has been awarded a Jean Monnet Centre of Excellence Award (2013), three Jean Monnet Chairs and several other Jean Monnet Modules and Learning EU at School projects. İstanbul BİLGİ University was awarded to hold one the WTO Chair titles worldwide for its project to establish a Research Center for International Trade Law and Arbitration. The establishment of the Research Center was approved by Turkish Council of High Education and the approval decision was published at the Turkish Official Gazette on 28th of September 2015. Through projected activities of the Research Center, BİLGİ is planning to help shaping an efficient and sustainable international trade policy on matters related to international trade law, arbitration and WTO in Türkiye and in its immediate region in broader sense. ▶ LEGAL CLINICS (Faculty of Law)

Istanbul Bilgi University Legal Clinics are formed under the roof of Faculty of Law and has been active since 2003. The method is based on "learning by doing" instead of experiencing theory in a protective and stimulated environment such as the classroom. Current Legal Clinics are focusing on access to justice individuals, especially for women and other disadvantaged groups.

Objectives are:

*Legal empowerment for the target groups (every clinic has a different target group)

*Skill building for the students (legal writing; public speaking; research)

Common learning aims for students:

- *Use law as a tool to empower people
- *Discuss law in a critical fashion
- *Identify the law applicable to the matter at hand including ethical rules in the profession
- *Use communication skills

The current Legal Clinic type is the client counselling program which has two subject matters (cyber law and women's access to justice). The counselling program students have client interviews to determine the legal problems; do research and write legal documents based on the problems; lastly, they give presentations and provide advice. The 'Applied Law Clinic on Cyber Rights' has been in action since 2014. In this program, students undertake human rights violation cases of freedom of speech, expression and information. The latest Clinic which is the 'Legal Clinic for Women's Access to Justice' has started in the 2023-2024 Fall semester. This Clinic aims to raise awareness among law students regarding various problems which hinder women's access to justice and to empower both the students and women in their efforts to overcome relevant barriers.

PDM offers adult, adolescent, and child psychotherapy, play therapy, couple and family therapy, psychological counseling, psychoeducation, group therapy,

psychological assessment tests and open access mental health resources. These services are designed to be accessible to individuals from all income levels. All group works, seminars, and webinars are offered as open to everyone, free-of-charge. PDM also aspires to support fellow mental health professionals, especially during collective traumas, to enhance their toolkits for community service.

In this presentation, we listened to psychoanalyst Lindsay Barton, who began to help us understand containment and anxiety in the face of profound disaster with personal and cultural repercussions. We explored how to understand our own needs as practitioners, drawn to help others while also needing help ourselves. Additionally, we discussed ways to understand our experiences and create internal as well as external systems of management.

6 and 7 April 2023

"When can I go home? Managing interpersonal care from within an institution."

In the wake of a natural disaster, we examined what happens to children who must live in group care. We considered the needs of these individual children amidst the multitude of challenges to manage. This presentation aimed to help practitioners understand the behaviors of these children and how to build relationships, talked about good health well-being and provide stability in the face of profound insecurity.
